

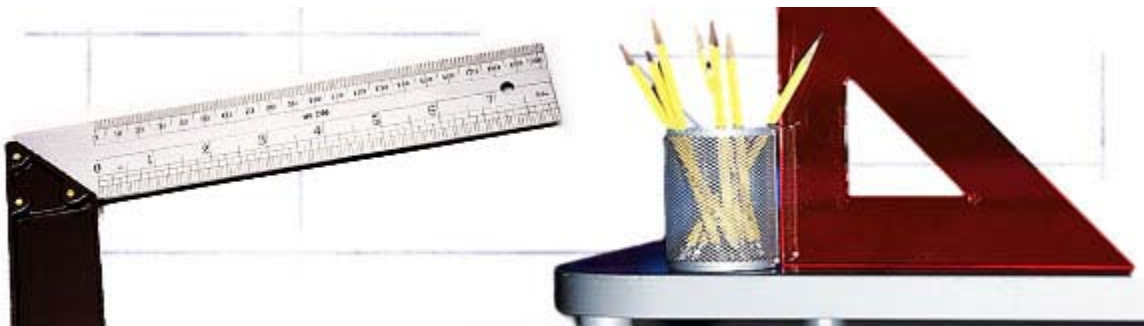

## NCARB resolution and fee increases

During the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards' (NCARB) Annual Meeting and Conference in San Francisco, CA, delegates representing 52 of the Council's 54 Member Boards that oversee the practice of architecture voted on five resolutions brought forth by the NCARB Board of Directors. These resolutions included:

- the elimination of the reciprocal credentialing opportunity requirement for Broadly Experienced Foreign Architect eligibility;
- the reduction of the notice period for IDP and education standard requirements from 90 days to 60 days;
- the revision of the alternative to the IDP;
