

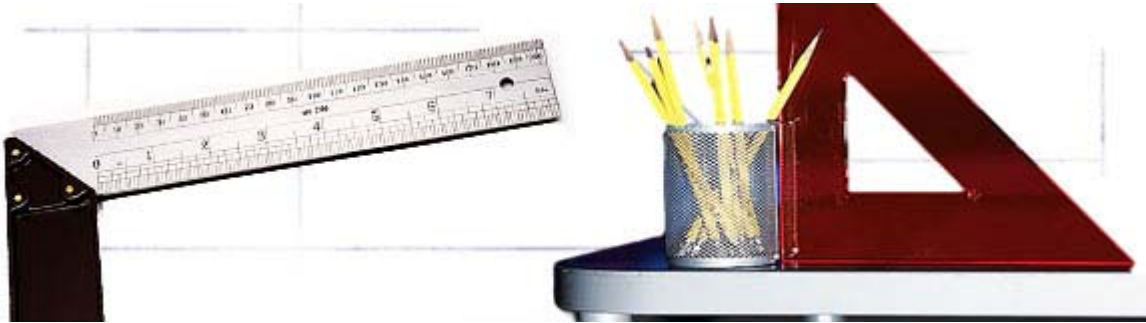

Each month, AIA Florida's goal is to provide all of Florida's emerging and young architects with the most up-to-date news about what matters most.

IDP Changes as of Oct. 1

NCARB recently announced additional changes to the Intern Development Program (IDP). As of Oct. 1, 2010, interns can accumulate training hours in four new ways:

Site Visit With Mentor:

Up to 40 core hours in "Construction Phase - Observation" for going on site visits with a mentor. Read the October 2010 IDP Guidelines for expectations when earning credit for the site visit.

Design Competition:

Up to 40 core hours of experience in each of the relevant IDP training areas 1-15. Your mentor is required to pre-approve the competition, oversee the competition entry, and ultimately certify the experience through the e-EVR. Read the October 2010 IDP Guidelines for expectations for both you and your mentor and the design competition criteria for how to determine if a competition is eligible for IDP credit.

Community-Based Design Center/Collaborative:

Up to 40 core hours of experience in each of the relevant IDP training areas 1-15 for volunteer service under the direct supervision of an IDP supervisor in support of an established non-profit entity (501(c)(3)) approved by NCARB. All organizations must apply to and be approved by NCARB prior to the work taking place in order to qualify for credit.

New IDP Eligibility Dates:

Your IDP eligibility date is the date after which you are able to earn IDP experience. As of 1 October 2010, you can start to earn IDP credit after you have successfully documented:

1. Enrollment in a NAAB/CACB-accredited degree program.
2. Enrollment in a pre-professional architecture degree program at a school that offers a NAAB/CACB-accredited degree program.
3. Employment in work setting A after obtaining a U.S. high school diploma or General Education Degree (GED) equivalent, or comparable foreign degree.

NCARB will visit in Nov.

This November, NCARB IDP Manager Martin Smith, AIA, NCARB, LEED GA, will be visiting three Schools of Architecture in Florida. Martin will be speaking to students at the University of South Florida on Wednesday, Nov. 10 mid-day, followed by the University of Florida in Gainesville in the evening, and FAMU on Nov. 19.

In addition, Martin will be traveling to AIA Northwest to make presentations in Pensacola and Destin on Nov. 18 & 19.

Martin is currently working with AIA Florida and State Coordinator Nathan Butler, AIA, LEED AP to organize AIA component visits in these areas.

Bronze Medal Criteria Change

At the AIA Florida Board meeting last week (Oct. 8) the Board of Directors voted to change the criteria for the AIA Florida Bronze Medal, as it relates to AIAS membership. Previously, recipients of the Bronze Medal were required to be members of their school's American Institute of Architecture Students (AIAS) organization.

The board of directors voted to eliminate this requirement. Bronze medals are awarded each year to one student in a Florida school of architecture as selected by the dean. Students should contact their dean for more information about this award and their selection process.
