Mickey Jacob, AIA Testifies for Finance and Taxation Committee

Today, Regional Director Mickey Jacob, AIA testified in front of the members of the Finance and Taxation Committee of the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission (TBRC) regarding proposals to tax services and the negative impact on small business in general and on architectural services particularly.



Jacob stated that, "This amendment would cause a seven percent decrease in the services architects would provide. It would double if not triple the tax on the same services. The affect would be on more than a small business, but also on the employees' daily lives."

Committee Commissioner, Robert Miller of the Florida Retail Federadtion stated that, "No one in their right mind would pass this amendment. This is not the way to do it."
