

## AIA Florida Announces 2025 Design and Honor Awards Recipients

**Tallahassee** – AIA Florida, the Florida Association of the American Institute of Architects, is pleased to <u>announce the recipients of the 2025</u> <u>Design and Honor Awards</u>, its prestigious annual awards program.

Juried this year in Athens, Greece, the Design Awards received the second-highest number of registrations in the program's history, with recognition given in 12 different categories, including historic preservation and restoration, sustainability, and awards of excellence in new work, renovations and additions, and interiors.

"It was my honor to bring the work of our AIA Florida members to Athens, Greece — a city internationally recognized as the cradle of Western architecture," said AIA Florida Immediate Past President and 2025 Design Awards Chair, Rhonda Hammond, AIA. "Sharing our members' innovative and inspiring projects in a place deeply rooted in architectural tradition was an unforgettable experience. The Greek jury, comprised of distinguished architects and educators, spent several days reviewing the submissions and thoughtfully considering each project."

"Each juror brought a unique, deep knowledge of theory, practice, education, and history; viewing all projects through a global lens, yet continuously looking for ways in which they reflected and engaged with the local surroundings and community. It was reassuring to see their concern with sustainability and the environment as they discussed all submissions," added 2025 AIA Florida President Elizabeth Camargo, AIA. "The exceptional work we shared with our peers in Greece made me feel very proud of my colleagues practicing in Florida."

Recipients will be honored during AIA Florida's 2025 Design and Honors Awards presentation on Saturday, August 2. This special occasion is regarded as the culminating event of AIA Florida's 2025 Annual Convention and Trade Show being held this year at the JW Marriott Tampa Water Street in Tampa, FL.
