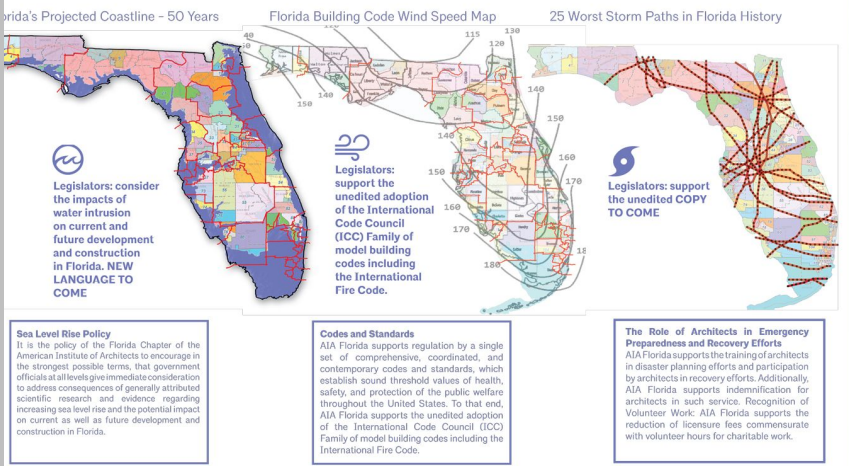
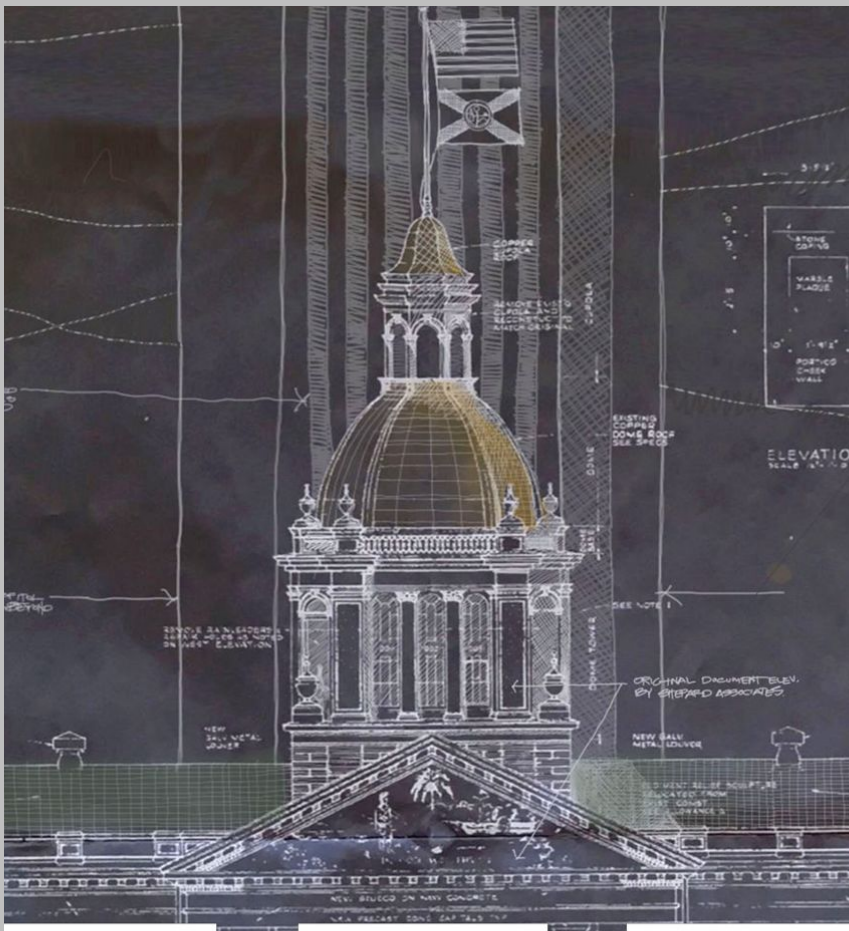

Five Forms of Flooding In Florida
