A Principal with Bora Architecture & Interiors, Amy Donohue has thirty years of experience designing spaces for education and the arts on university campuses across the country. Amy was an assistant design instructor at Princeton University and adjunct professor for architectural design at the University of Oregon (2001-2007). Since June 2014, Amy has been a member of the Board of Directors for Literary Arts and currently serves as Chair.

Trained in Design Justice, Amy has been instrumental in the creation of Bora's equity framework and action plan. She is currently leading the firm's effort to co-develop workforce housing for young Black professionals in the AEC industry, seeking to grow the pipeline of diversity in the profession.
