Licensed as an architect in the U.S. (16 states) and Canada (one province), Kai-Uwe most recently contributed to the East Side Coastal Resiliency Project (the BIG U), a resiliency plan that will protect 10 miles of Manhattan's coastline. Additionally, his work expands to the exhibition and publication of BIG's literary portfolio by way of *Hot to Cold*, *Yes Is More*, *Formgiving*, and the newest *Culture* book. He complements his professional work through teaching assignments at Pratt Institute and Georgia Tech. Kai-Uwe is also an AIA Fellow and past board member of the Van Alen Institute, and participates on numerous international juries and in lectures globally on the works of BIG.
