



Opportunity in Panama

Fourth Transmission Line Chiriquí Grande-Panamá III 500KV

Panama's Electricity Transmission Company ([ETESA](#)) began prequalifying companies for the design and construction project of the fourth transmission line from Chiriquí Grande to Panamá III (est. over \$520 million). The Fourth Line will have a transport capacity of 1280MVA/1,400 MW under normal operating conditions and 1,800 MW under emergency conditions. According to ETESA, the project has two phases: the first will consist of construction of the transmission line, with approximately 317 km in length, construction of the Chiriquí Grande 230 KV substation and the expansion of the Panamá III substation. In this phase, the line will operate at 230 KV, while phase II will include the 500 KV.

ETESA, in collaboration with IFC (member of the World Bank Group), is prequalifying companies to ensure that the contractor has the financial and technical capabilities to develop the project. The project is expected to be tendered and awarded this year with operations to start in 2022.

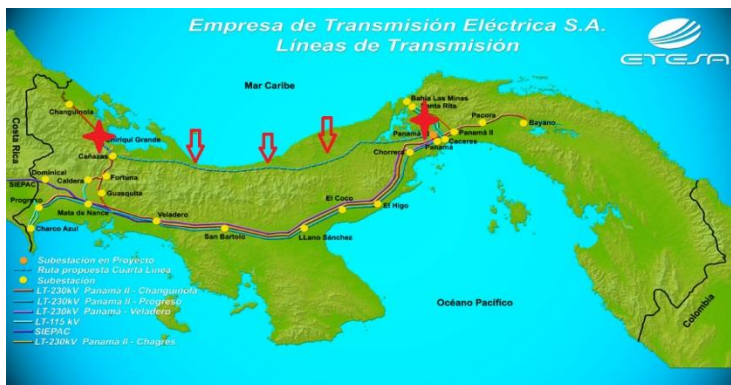
DEADLINE to submit proposals is July 12, 2018.
