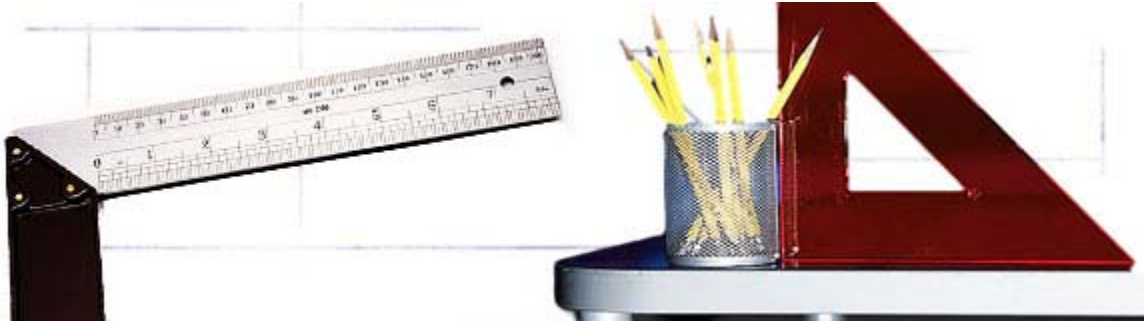

Save the Date! IDP 2.0 Final Phase: April 2012

The final phase of IDP 2.0 will go into effect for interns on April 3, 2012. This implementation will include:

- New experience categories and areas
- Simplified experience settings
- New electronic experience reporting system
- Credit for academic internships
- Broader definition of an IDP supervisor

Here are a few things to keep in mind as you prepare for the final phase:

- All hours will be rolled over to IDP 2.0.
- The total hours required to complete the IDP (5,600) will remain the same.
- The total core minimum hours required to complete the program is increasing to 3,740 for everyone--an increase of 20 hours from the current requirement.
