Tallahassee – AIA Florida, the Florida Association of the American Institute of Architects, is pleased to [recognize the recipients of the 2024 Design Awards](#), its prestigious annual awards program.

Juried this year in Seoul, South Korea, the Design Awards received a record number of registrations with recognition given to 84 entrants in 12 different categories including historic preservation and restoration, sustainability, and awards of excellence in new work, renovations and additions, and interiors.

"This year we were reminded about the universality of architecture and design and its transcendent bridging of the gap through language and cultural differences," 2024 AIA Florida President, Rhonda Hammond, AIA, shared.
