



Deborah Reid, Esq. is a pre-eminently rated attorney and an accomplished artist. Reid creates colorful, highly visual seminars and books on subjects at the intersection of art and law. She presents lectures internationally for the American Bar Association, professional organizations, universities, art schools and cultural organizations.
