### **Public Reception for “Picture Tallahassee: Where We Live, Work & Play”**

**TALLAHASSEE, Fla.** - The American Institute of Architects in conjunction with the Florida Foundation for Architecture and the Tallahassee Council on Culture and Arts will host on Friday, January 27, an opening night for the new photography exhibit "Picture Tallahassee: Where We Live, Work and Play." Photographs featured focus on the architecture and naturally built environment as seen in and around Tallahassee.

Picture Tallahassee: Where We Live, Work & Play is a juried, fine art photography exhibition that celebrates community design as an art form. 26 images featuring architecture in the Tallahassee area are on display. Diverse in style and subject matter, some of the photographs convey the impressive weight of concrete and steel, while others capture the delicacy of nature reflected in glass. By exhibiting artful images of the physical structures where we live, work, and play, this exhibition demonstrates that our built environment has the power to summon an emotional connection in people.
